Stephen Barstow has devoted over 30 years to trialing over 3,000 of the world's perennial vegetables. It is unlikely that anyone anywhere has tried as many different species of edible plants. His salad comprising of 538 varieties in 2003 earned him the title of 'Extreme Salad Man!' Stephen's garden in Norway has over 2,000 edibles, and takes two days to tour.



Matt Van Boven is the creator of the Feral Farm Mythos. He is a Homesteader, Edible Plant Expert, and Natural Builder. Matt has over 20 years' experience with forest gardening and has designed and implemented many models. In the fall of 1997, he began Feral Farm, a 46-acre Agroforestry Project located in the Sauk River Valley of Washington state.
